Hemorrhagic Stroke	Ischemic Stroke
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Large volume intracerebral hematoma greater than 5 cm on CT• Concern for expanding hematoma• Hunt Hess Score ≥ 3• Rapidly declining mental status, especially requiring intubation• All SAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• NIHSS ≥ 6• Signs & symptoms consistent with large vessel occlusion (“Drip and Ship”)• Stroke in the young (<55 yo)
